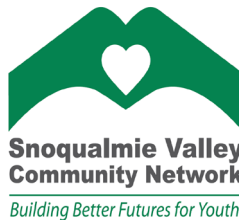

TBRI uses **Empowering Principles** to address physical needs, **Connecting Principles** to address attachment needs and **Correcting Principles** to address the balance of structure and nurture in addressing fear based behaviors.

This is a free six-week class series and is open to parents and caregivers of elementary and middle school children.
