



Youth Ambassadors Role Description/Application:

Empower Youth Network is looking for individuals in middle & high school who are interested in outreach and informing peers about the free youth events EYN hosts throughout the year. As well as community outreach events. This person will have the responsibility of learning about events, spreading the word to others via social media and word of mouth, and attending youth-based focus groups. These focus groups will be with other youth ambassadors in the program where we meet to discuss current activities/events, suggestions on details to make the events run their best, and ideas on how to spread the word to other youth in the community. Additionally, there will be opportunities for officer positions.

The group will meet once a month to discuss the above information. We will meet once a month, in person at the Empower Youth Network office in Carnation (time will be determined by the group, but will be after school), to discuss agenda items: program updates, community service activities, marketing strategies, volunteer opportunities and any other ideas you come up with.

You will be required to volunteer at one youth event every 3 months hosted by Empower Youth Network (3 events in total over the school year). This is where you can earn volunteer hours.

By joining the Youth Ambassador Program, you are committing to attending meetings and events. We recognize that you are all involved in multiple activities within and outside of school, so if things come up in conflict with a meeting, we ask you to communicate that as soon as possible to the Youth Engagement Coordinator or President. You are required to come to the meetings otherwise. Your input matters and is important to make this group run. Failure to inform the Youth Engagement Coordinator or the President of an absence within 3 hours of the meeting may result in suspension/termination from the group after two offenses.

Key roles:

- Participate in community centered activity in meetings
- Discuss ways to promote Youth Events
- Attend monthly meetings (1 meeting per month in person)
- Share events in school setting and let other peers know about them
- Participate actively in conversations throughout the year
- Opportunity to hold officer positions
- Work with peers to help others in the community learn about Empower Youth Network's free youth events

Benefits of the ambassador role:

As a youth ambassador you are eligible to receive community service hours during each meeting and during events. Anywhere from 7-30 hours in a school year. Become a leader within your community and share ideas that will be implemented within the Snoqualmie Valley. This opportunity can help you build your resume with experience working with other youth and helping a non-profit organization.
